PERSONALIZE IT: When you pray a Bible verse, put your name and situation into the verse. There is power in God's word. And it does our mind GREAT good to speak those promises out loud.

FIXING MY WAYWARD THOUGHTS:

- 2. I'm dead to that useless thought. That's not me anymore. Jump to the new thought.
- 3. Thank you, Lord for... (new thought).
- 4. Focus on my end goal.

FREEING THOUGHT

- 1. I'm dead to that old habit.
- 2. I'm alive to this new thought.

SMILE

I'm gaining a new useful habit.

<u>NOTE</u>: We choose to be angry because of current or past pain. Anger poisons our minds, and when expressed, injures our relationships. The Bible says:

<u>Matthew 5:44</u> But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,

Matthew 7:12 Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets. [Check out how God will help... Keep reading...]

<u>Philippians 2:12-13</u> ...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.

<u>Ephesians 4:32</u> ... be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ forgave you.

James 1:19-20 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath [anger]; for the wrath [anger] of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

Leviticus. 19:18 You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the Lord.

Proverbs 15:1 A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

Proverbs 20:22 Do not say, "I will recompense [pay back] evil"; Wait for the Lord, and He will save you.

Luke 6:35 But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.

<u>Colossians 3:12-13</u> Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another...even as Christ forgave you



Romans 8:38-39 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Psalm 37:23-24 The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, and He delights in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; for the Lord upholds him with His hand.

Psalm 43:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; for I shall yet praise Him...

<u>Psalm 119:28</u> My soul melts from heaviness; strengthen me according to Your word.

Isaiah 57:15 For thus says the High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite [crushed] ones."

Isaiah 61:1-3 "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord..."

Psalm 147:3 He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

Jeremiah 31:16-17 Thus says the Lord: "Refrain your voice from weeping, and your eyes from tears; for your work shall be rewarded, says the Lord, and they shall come back from the land of the enemy. There is hope in your future, says the Lord, that your children shall come back to their own border."

Ezekiel 34:11-12, 16a 'For thus says the Lord God: "Indeed I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out. As a shepherd seeks out his flock on the day he is among his scattered sheep, so will I seek out My sheep and deliver them from all the places where they were scattered on a cloudy and dark day... "I will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick...

Isaiah 66:2 "But on this one will I look: On him who is poor and of a contrite spirit, and who trembles at My word.





<u>**Romans 3:23**</u> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God [We all make mistakes]

<u>Romans 5:1-2</u> Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

John 3:17 "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved"

Psalm 103:11-14 For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great is His mercy toward those who fear Him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. As a father pities his children, so the Lord pities those who fear Him. For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:21</u> "For He [God] made Him [Jesus] who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him".

Ephesians 1:7 "In Him we have redemption through His blood, <u>the</u> forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace".

Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, and let us reason together," says the Lord, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool."

Hebrews 8:12 "For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more" [In His great mercy, God erases your sin from His memory!]

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

<u>Micah 7:18-19</u> Who is a God like You, pardoning iniquity and passing over the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He does not retain His anger forever, because He delights in mercy. He will again have compassion on us, and will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea.

<u>2</u> Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Luke 23:33-34 And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left. Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." [Stephen also prayed similarly <u>Acts 7:59</u>]

<u>1 John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

<u>Matthew 18:21-22</u> Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven.

<u>Matthew 6:14-15</u> "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Luke 6:37 "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

Matthew 5:7 Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.
